## Lee Bank branch renovation enters first phase

And so it begins!

We are eager to report that the renovation of the Great Barrington Lee Bank branch will begin this month. Allegrone Construction will be on site to begin phase one of the project, starting in mid-January. During this phase, our customers will temporarily enter through the back of the building, from the parking lot off of Church Street. The branch will receive new stairs out the back entrance, temporary walls, and doors to make it possible for customers to enter while the front half of the branch undergoes construction. During this time, only customers who require handicap accessibility may use the front door of the branch.

We will be OPEN regular hours including Saturdays during construction. For a

At some point there will be a short disruption of ATM/ Night Drop service while we replace the old machines. Except for this short time, the ATM and Night Drop will be available for the duration of the project in the front of the building.
